

Plans underway for new park in Palm City

PALM CITY — Plans are underway for a new community park in Palm City with baseball/softball diamonds and soccer fields that also also double as football and lacrosse fields.

Kevin Landry, county park planning and development administrator, discussed the potential development — to be known as Citrus Grove Community Park — with Growth Management personnel at their meeting Thursday morning.

The next stage in the creation of the 20-acre site in the Tuscawilla Development will be the submission of a final site plan in about six weeks, according to Landry.

Construction is slated to be completed sometime in 2012.

When the plans for the park were first discussed, it was known as Tuscawilla Park. The initial blueprint called for construction of a baseball field for handicapped athletes but that was scrapped as there currently is such a facility at Sailfish Park.
